## Winterberry Co-pollination

Winterberry (*Ilex verticillata*) comes as either a male or female plant. Only female flowers fertilized by pollen from the correct male will produce the plant's signature red berries.

The charts below show the co-pollinators for Winterberry, including some older varieties that you may have in your garden and want to pair, and pollination timing for some more popular varieties. One male plant should pollinate 6-10 females.

Winterberry is easy to grow, thrives in damp areas, will reach approximately 12' high by 12' wide at maturity and is hardy in zones 3-9.
